

All About the Disney World *Dining* Plan



Enjoy delicious prepaid meals and more when you purchase a dining plan as part of a Disney Resort Hotel Package!

To purchase, add this extra on to your Disney Vacation Package.

The Disney Dining Plan (DDP) is a prepaid meal program offered by Walt Disney World for guests staying at Disney Resort hotels. It allows guests to pre-pay for a set number of meals, snacks, and beverages, making it easier to budget and enjoy dining at the resort and parks.



Dining plans can add the convenience and flexibility of prepaid meals and snacks to your vacation—and give you peace of mind.

There are more than 200 locations to dine at throughout our Disney Resort hotels, theme parks and select locations at Disney Springs. So there's something to delight nearly every taste!

Convenience & Flexibility

Delicious Options:

Choose from either the Disney Quick-Service Dining Plan or the Disney Dining Plan as part of a Walt Disney Travel Company Package. Both plans provide everyone in the party (ages 3 and over) a specific number of meals and snacks based on the number of nights of your Disney Resort stay. Just pick the plan that works best with your vacation style and dining needs!

Dine and Snack at Your Own Pace:

Meals and snacks can be redeemed at any time during your stay. Unused meals and snacks will roll over day to day and expire at midnight on day of checkout.

For example, if you book a 4-night package with a dining plan that includes one snack per day, each Guest (ages 3 and up) in your party would receive 4 snacks—which can be used at any time during your 4-night stay.



Value & Savings

Discover the value of dining plans —and find out how families with little ones can save on dining!

Dining plans include a certain number of prepaid meals and snacks—so you can spend more time with your family enjoying the Disney magic... and less time on meal budgeting while you're here at Walt Disney World Resort. **And this gives you the opportunity to say that magic word to your kids... "Yes."**

You can save up to 20% on dining for kids ages 3 to 9 when you purchase a dining plan for your family as part of a Walt Disney Travel Company package.

QUICK SERVICE DINING

With the Disney Quick-Service Dining Plan you can **dine at a variety of Quick-Service locations when you're ready to stop and enjoy a casual meal.** Order at a counter or register and then find a seat—no dining reservations required!

WHAT'S INCLUDED:

Everyone in the party ages 3 & over receives the following:

- 2 Quick-Service Meals (per night of stay)*
- 1 Snack/Nonalcoholic Drink (per night of stay)*
- 1 Resort-Refillable Drink Mug**

* Specific number of meals and snacks are determined by the number of nights included in the package stay. Meals and snacks can be redeemed at any time during your stay. Unused meals and snacks will roll over day to day and expire at midnight on day of checkout. Meals and snacks are nontransferable between party members.

** Resort-refillable mugs are eligible for refills from self-service beverage islands at any Disney Resort hotel Quick-Service location.

Important Information

- Beverages are included with each meal. Guests under 21 years of age may choose from a variety of nonalcoholic beverages. Guests 21 and older with valid identification may substitute for beer, wine and cocktails.
- Guests ages 3 to 9 must order from a children's menu, where available.
- Plan must be purchased for entire length of stay and for the entire party (ages 3 and up).

Remember, meals and snacks can be redeemed at any time during your stay.

For example, if you book a 4-night package with a Disney Quick-Service Dining Plan, each Guest (ages 3 and up) in your party would receive 8 Quick-Service meals and 4 Snacks or Nonalcoholic Beverages—which can be used at any time during your 4-night stay.

DISNEY DINING PLAN (TABLE SERVICE COMBO)

Want to slow down a little and savor special family moments over sit-down meals—or watch the kids light up during Character Dining? Then the Disney Dining Plan is the perfect choice to experience classic dining options at both Quick-Service and Table-Service restaurants, including Character Dining locations.

This option allows you to easily plan meals around your family's schedule: Quick-Service when you're on the go and Table-Service when you're ready to savor the moment.

What's Included

Everyone in the party ages 3 and over receives the following:

- 1 Quick-Service Meal (per night of stay)*
- 1 Table-Service Meal (per night of stay)*
- 1 Snack/Nonalcoholic Drink (per night of stay)*
- 1 Resort-Refillable Drink Mug**

* Specific number of meals and snacks are determined by the number of nights included in the package stay. Meals and snacks can be redeemed at any time during your stay. Unused meals and snacks will roll over day to day and expire at midnight on day of checkout. Meals and snacks are nontransferable between party members.

** Resort-refillable mugs are eligible for refills from self-service beverage islands at any Disney Resort hotel Quick-Service location.

- Reservations at Table-Service restaurants are subject to availability and are highly recommended.
- Two table-service meals will be redeemed from the dining plan for each person dining at a Fine/Signature Dining experience, select Character Dining experience or a Dinner Show.
- Guests ages 3 to 9 must order from a children's menu, where available.
- Plan must be purchased for the entire length of stay and for the entire party (ages 3 and up).

Dine and Snack at Your Own Pace

Remember, meals and snacks can be redeemed at any time during your stay.

For example, if you book a 4-night package with a Disney Dining Plan, each Guest (ages 3 and up) in your party would receive 4 Table-Service meals, 4 Quick-Service meals and 4 snacks or nonalcoholic beverages—which can be used at any time during your 4-night stay.

How to *use* your Disney Dining Plan

Follow these simple steps to enjoy delicious meals and tasty treats with your dining plan.

Step One: Choose a Restaurant
Review a list of restaurants participating in your dining plan.

Step Two: Show ID

Simply present your valid Disney Resort ID (MagicBand, Disney MagicMobile pass or Key to the World card) to your server or cashier at participating restaurants.

Step Three: Track It

There are 3 easy ways to track your dining plan meals and snacks.

- Use the My Disney Experience app
- Check your most recent dining receipt
- Visit the Resort Concierge or any Guest Relations location and ask about your remaining meals and snacks

To track your remaining meals and snacks via the My Disney Experience app, visit the “My Resort Stay” section. Then, select “Check Dining Plan” to view the status of your dining plan meals and snacks—total issued, already redeemed and still available.

Use Mobile Order for your *Quick Service* dining.

Use your dining plan to **place an order on the go with the My Disney Experience app.**

Download the app to view eligible restaurants and items, then make your selection! This convenient service includes:
